Training is needed in order to love properly; and to be able to find happiness and joy, you must practice *deep looking* directed toward the person you love. Because if you do not understand this person, you cannot love properly. Understanding is the essence of love. If you cannot understand, you cannot love. That is the message of the Buddha. If a husband [or wife], for example, does not understand [their spouse'] deepest troubles, [their] deepest aspirations, if [they do] not understand [their spouse'] suffering, [they] will not be able to love [their spouse] in the right way. Without understanding, love is an impossible thing.

What must we do in order to understand a person? We must have time; we must practice looking deeply into this person. We must be there, attentive; we must observe, we must look deeply.
